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Washing Guide.



Wash microfiber cloths cold, maximum temperature 30/40°C (86/104° F). (Melting point of microfiber is 60° C / 140° F).



Soak heavily soiled cloths in microfiber detergent before washing.



Wash cloths according to their intended use to avoid cross contamination.



Always wash new microfiber cloths before first use to remove any production residue.



Use special microfiber detergent which is free from fragrance, dyes, bleach, softeners etc.



Do not wash microfiber cloths with other fabrics/materials (e.g. cotton).



Use liquid detergent. Powder may leave residue.



Wash new, dark microfiber cloths separately from lighter microfiber cloths to avoid discoloration.



Do not use fabric softener as it gums up the fibers.



Tumble dry on low heat or carefully beat out cloths and hang on the line.



Do not use chlorine bleach.



Do not iron.

General notes

Assign a single use to each wipe. After use, store in a laundry bag or discard container. After washing, store away from dust and dirt.
